The Application Process

1. Complete the Lift Johnstown Scholarship Challenge application. Open applications will be accepted and processed until June 30, 2011.
2. Submit a financial aid* application to www.factstuitionaid.com.
3. Once you have received confirmation that you are financially qualified for the program, you will meet with an admissions representative at BMCHS and will need to submit the following:
 - BMCHS application
 - Essay about a person who has been a positive influence in your life
 - Three letters of recommendation on the forms provided
4. The Admissions Office will review all materials, including Junior high academic record and disciplinary records, and they will be presented to the Lift Johnstown Scholarship Committee for review. The scholarship committee, comprised of school and community leaders, will review the qualified applications for admission and make recommendations to the BMCHS's Admissions Office for acceptance into the program.
5. Applicants offered admission to the school through the Lift Scholarship Program will be required to register as a new student at BMCHS before August 1, 2011.
